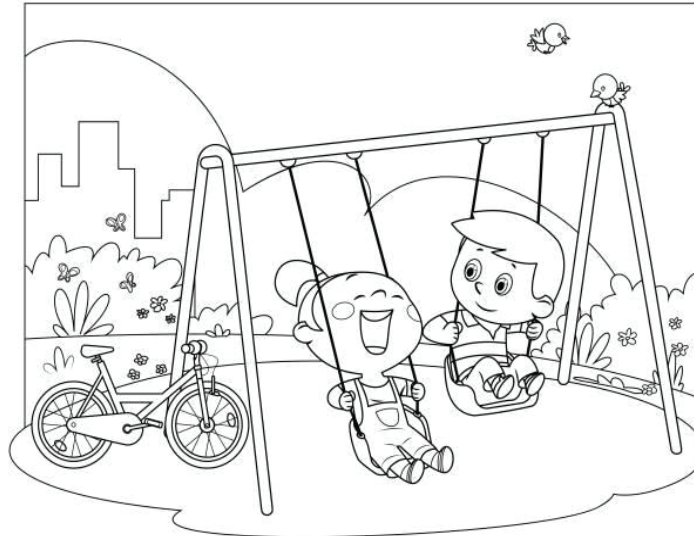

### Having a Good Sleep

- 1) Sleeping well is important for your health and body. If you do not get enough sleep, you will feel tired the whole day. Your body will not work well, and you may not be able to think wisely. There are some steps that you can follow to get a better night's sleep.
- 2) First, you should go to bed early. Staying up late and waking up early means that you get less sleep than your body needs. Sleeping at night and in the day are not the same. Doctors say that sleeping early will give you a better kind of sleep. It is also important that you go to bed at the same time every night. This will help your body follow the right routine. You should also do this on the weekends and during holidays.
- 3) Your room should also be suitable for sleeping. It should be clean, tidy, and dark. The temperature (دَرَجَةُ حَرَارَةٍ) also needs to be right—it should not be too hot or too cold. Your bed and pillows should be clean and comfortable.
- 4) You may be surprised to know that good exercise will also help you sleep well. Your body needs to sleep in order to get rest. If you do not exercise you will not be tired. Your body will not have a good reason to sleep. It is important to exercise in the morning or in the afternoon. Exercising at night may make you more awake!
- 5) Always remember that good sleep is good for your body and soul!
