## F. Reading Comprehension

- (1) Tamir wants to be a good student and tries hard. However, he does not do well on most of his tests. He always studies hard, and he keeps studying longer each day. But his test scores do not get better. This makes him feel bad about himself.
- (2) Tamir's parents are worried about him. They want him to do well and would like him to be happy. They work with him on his studies and encourage him, but his test scores don't get better. They now want him to talk to the school counselor (مُستشارة). They think she can help him.
- (3) Tamir visits the counselor to talk about his study **issues**. The counsellor thinks Tamir's main problem is that he is not active when he is learning and studying. To get Tamir to be active, the counselor suggests taking notes in class, doing things when studying (not just re-reading), and forming a study group.
- (4) Taking notes will help Tamir pay attention in class, and he can use **them** later to study. When studying, he should not just read but *do* things like making idea maps and diagrams (رَسْمٌ تَوْضِيحِيٌّ / بَيَانِيٌّ). He can also explain things to himself step by step and mark questions he can come back to answer later. He can make quizzes for himself and explain ideas to others. Studying with other classmates can also help him a lot.
- (5) Tamir is excited to try the counselor's ideas. He makes a study group with two classmates, and he takes notes in class. When studying alone, he makes idea maps and diagrams and explains things aloud to himself. He works with his study group each week and enjoys doing practice tests with them.
- (6) Tamir is now active in his own learning. He enjoys it a lot and learns more. Best of all, his test scores are much better than before. He took the school counselor's advice, and he is now a successful student who feels good about himself. And his parents are happy, too!
