#### Volunteering

Volunteering can be fun and make a big difference in the lives of the volunteers and of others. When teenagers volunteer, they help make their community and environment better. For example, volunteering at a food bank helps feed hungry families, and cleaning parks makes them better places for everyone.
- (2) Volunteering helps teenagers learn new skills. They can learn how to work with others, solve problems, and be responsible. For example, if they volunteer at an animal shelter, they learn how to take care of animals. If they help at a school, they learn how to teach and help younger kids. Such skills are important for teenagers and will likely help them in their studies and in finding a better job after they graduate.
- (3) When teenagers volunteer, they meet new people and make friends. They work with other volunteers who care about the same things. This can be a lot of fun and help them feel like part of a team. Making new friends and meeting new people can make volunteering more enjoyable and less stressful. They can share their experiences and learn from each other, and this can create strong friendships.
- (4) Volunteering can also make teenagers feel good about themselves. Helping others can help them feel proud and satisfied because making a difference feels good! In addition, volunteering can help teenagers feel more relaxed. Seeing the smiles on the faces of the people they help makes teenagers see that they can make a difference in other's lives. Feeling good about themselves helps them have a positive attitude and better mental health.
- (5) The skills and experiences that teenagers get from volunteering help them when they apply for a college or a job. Colleges and employers like to see that teenagers have volunteered because it shows <u>they</u> care about others and their communities, and that they can work hard. Volunteering also helps teenagers decide what they might want to do when they grow up. They might discover a passion for teaching, helping animals, or working in healthcare.
